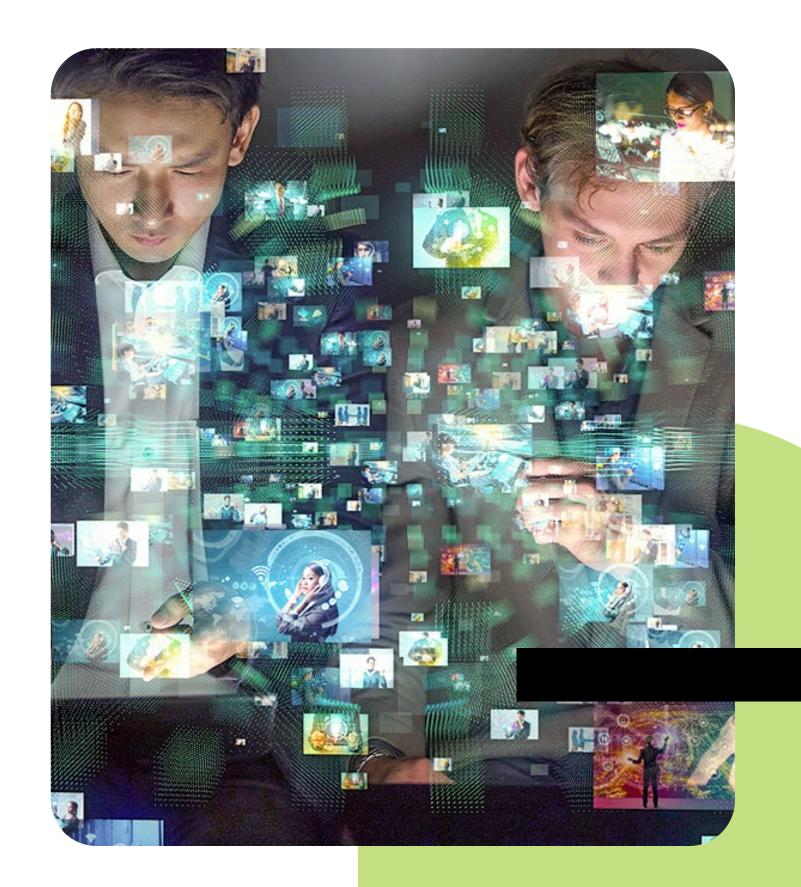


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Introduction

CCWD's Finance and Human Resources

Departments have kicked off the Core Financials and Payroll/Personnel Management Implementation through Tyler Technologies. This part of the implementation is a follow-up to the Utility Billing (UB) and A/R modules that went live in September 2021. Once this portion of the system has gone live, all Tyler modules will be integrated with each other.



Project Overview

Establish CCWD's functional leaders who are authorized to make procedural decisions within their department.

Establish CCWD power users who are the experts in their field and are responsible for providing insight to current processes and ensure the configuration in the Tyler system are the most efficient.

phases, culminating in an
integrated system that brings
together the UB, Finance and
Human Resources
departments.

Core Financials Block Implementation (3-4 weeks)

Configuration, training, testing and final data push to go live in the Core Financials,
Purchasing, and Bank
Reconciliation modules in
Tyler.

Payroll Block Implementation (5-7 weeks)

Configuration, training, testing, parallel payroll processing, and final data push to go live in the Personnel Management and Employee Access Promodules in Tyler.

Ancillary Implementation (2 weeks)

Current/future state analysis, configuration and training to go live in the ESS Time & Attendance, Fixed Assets, Project Accounting and Budgeting modules in Tyler.
