CALIFORNIA POPPY

This wildflower tolerates low water conditions and thrives when it's hot and dry. Bright orange or yellow blooms add big color to your garden and attract pollinators like bees and butterflies which are healthy for your yard.

MANZANITA

Manzanita offers deep red, twisted branches and shiny, evergreen leaves. It also provides essential habitat for birds and insects. Many varieties of manzanita are waterwise and thrive in various soil types.



YARROW

A hardy plant that comes back year after year with beautiful clusters of small, delicate flowers in white, pink and yellow. It also attracts pollinators like bees and butterflies. Yarrow thrives in various soil types and is a low-maintenance addition to any garden.

CALIFORNIA FUCHSIA

A vibrant plant that comes back year after year with bright, reddish-pink flowers. It attracts hummingbirds and other pollinators, and its ability to thrive in dry conditions makes it waterwise and low-maintenance.





CEANOTHUS

This group of plants includes shrubs, tress, and groundcovers that are all great choices for waterwise gardens. Many species of ceanothus thrive in a range of soil types and are tolerant of low water availability. They also attract pollinators like bees, butterflies, and birds!
