#### SUMMARY:

On July 28, 2017, the Calaveras County Water District staff was notified by the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) that its Ebbetts Pass Redwood Tank Replacement Project Notice of Interest (NOI) was determined to be an eligible Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HGMP) activity and Cal OES invited the District to submit a full grant application.

This grant is seeking funding to replace five redwood tanks in the Ebbetts Pass service area that are highly vulnerable to destruction by wildfire:

- Heather Drive, serving Forest Meadows (500,000 gal.)
- Valley View Drive, serving Timber Trails in Avery (60,000 gal.)
- Big Trees 4 and 5, on Bigfoot Circle serving Camp Connell (100,000 gal. each)
- Big Trees 8, near Hwy. 4 across from Meko Drive serving Camp Connell (100,000 gal.)

Because redwood tanks are vulnerable to wildfire, their replacement is listed as a high priority in the District's Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP). The installation of fire-resistant steel tanks will help safeguard these facilities from wildfire and protect vital water supplies for thousands of residential customers, who have no other potable water source.

The District estimates the project will cost \$3.2 million, of which \$2.4 million (75%) would be federal grant funds from Cal OES, and the required 25% local match of \$800,000

would come from the District's Water Capital Renovation and Replacement Fund (Capital R&R)(Fund 125).

The HMGP DR-4301 application requires the CCWD Board to designate an Authorizing Agent to sign and execute the grant application and funding match commitment letter. This letter will be submitted to Cal OES with the full grant application, which is due on November 1, 2017.

#### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The HMGP requires a 75/25 percent local cost share match requiring CCWD to authorize a funding commitment for \$800,000 of the estimated total project cost of \$3.2 million. Staff recommends matching funds come from the Water Capital Renovation and Replacement Fund (Fund 125).

# A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

DESIGNATING THE GENERAL MANAGER AS AUTHORIZING AGENT AND AUTHORIZING FUNDING MATCH COMMITMENT LETTER FOR THE EBBETTS PASS REDWOOD TANK REPLACEMENT PROJECT HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION, DR-4301-0022 CCWD CIP #11095

WHEREAS, the Calaveras County Water District (CCWD) supplies potable water for public use to the communities of Camp Connell, Big Trees Village, Snowshoe Springs, Timber Trails and Forest Meadows along State Route 4 in Calaveras County, California, through the use of redwood storage tanks installed around 1970; and

WHEREAS, these communities are located within the wildland-urban interface in a very high fire hazard severity zone according to Cal-Fire and identified as communities at risk from potential catastrophic wildfire; and

WHEREAS, the District's adopted Local Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies the loss of potable water as an extreme risk because of the high fire hazard and vulnerability of the existing redwood tanks to wildfire, and protection of the potable water storage facilities is determined to be a high priority mitigation action; and

WHEREAS, CCWD staff is applying for assistance through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), DR-4301-0022, to mitigate against the loss of potable water storage facilities from the risk of future wildfires in the subject communities; and

WHEREAS, the HMGP application requires Board 'designation' of an Authorizing Agent to sign and execute said grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Board authorizes the execution of a 'Funding Match Commitment Letter' on CCWD letterhead authorizing a local 25 percent funding match requirement of \$800,000 of the estimated engineering total cost of \$3.2 million for the mitigation project for new ignition-resistant steel tanks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Calaveras County Water District that designates the General Manager, or designee, as the Applicant's Agent and approves the Funding Match Commitment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Manager is authorized to execute the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, DR-4301-0022, application for the Ebbetts Pass Redwood Tank Replacement Project and funding match commitment, and such other documents and assurance as necessary to obtain grant funding under this application.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that funding for the District's cost share shall come from the Water Capital Renovation and Replacement Fund (Fund 125).
