## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The Calaveras County Water District proposes to construct the Jenny Lind Water Treatment Plant Pretreatment Improvements (CCWD CIP #11092 / DR-4240-CA, PJ#0001) project consisting of a packaged pretreatment system that will be manufactured offsite and shipped to the site for installation.
