Subject: Planned Construction in Rancho Calaveras Area (Valley Springs)

DRM Construction will begin work in the vicinity of Redman Road and O'Reilly Street in the Rancho Calaveras area beginning on January 22nd, which could last into early March depending upon weather conditions. The Calaveras County Water District is working with the contractor to install three underground pressure reducing valves as part of long-term planned service pressure improvements. Construction will be taking place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. Please use caution when approaching construction areas. Work will begin at the intersection of O'Reilly Street and McAtee Street, next at the intersection at Goggin Street and McAtee Street, and the last pressure regulating station will be installed at the intersection of Goggin Street and Redman Road.

Note that temporary shutdowns of water service to residential customers will be necessary while the valves are put in place. A door tag will be hung by a District employee, at least 48 hours in advance, at the customer properties that may be affected.

The first scheduled shutdown will take place on January 24th from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (*weather permitting*) and will affect two residences near the intersection of O' Reilly Street and McAtee Street.

The District will work to notify residents in a timely manner of further temporary shutdowns and project schedule progress. The District appreciates your patience as the District works to implement these vital upgrades to the water system.
