The District's collection and distribution systems throughout the County total 287.5 miles of water pipe and 125 miles of sewer. A variety of technologies such as SCADA are used in the District's treatment facilities.

THE POSITION...The successful candidate will join the District's engineering department which currently employees two Civil Engineers, an Engineering Technician, Engineering Coordinator, and a Construction Inspector. The department has a long list of CIP and other operation projects that are in need of design for the next several years. This position is located at the District headquarters in San Andreas in Calaveras County.
